

# **SEASON STRUCTURE:**

- 12-13 weeks (depending on tournament participation)
  - 4 week pre-season of 2 training sessions per week and possible Saturdays (team dependent)
  - 8 game season in the CSA Front Range League
    - 4 Home @ the Future Legends Complex/Windsor Middle School or Eastman Park
    - 4 Away (hopefully along the Front Range north of Denver but that is TBD)
  - Fall CSA league play typically begins end of August and finishes end of October
  - Spring CSA league play typically begins early March and ends late-May
  - Optional Weekly 'Tech Nights' for WDP and Competitive Warriors players
  - Optional off-season programming to include Indoor soccer leagues, futsal camps/leagues, camps/clinics, private coaching through specialized coaches (all at an additional cost)

# WDP PLAY EXPECTATIONS:

- Attend 2 x 90 minute team training sessions per week in-season
  - Punctuality is required!!
  - WWAFC training sessions are planned to be held between 5pm and 930pm next season depending on field space
  - They will likely take place on Monday and Wednesday each week.
  - We aim to schedule our younger players (i.e. U11 and below) during the earlier time slots - i.e. 5pm to 630pm
- Attend ALL 8 games!
  - Outside of extenuating circumstances, we need our full squads for ALL games
  - We will try to avoid scheduling games around holiday weekends and school breaks but our options are very limited by the CSA schedules

• Commit to our 'Warriors Way' code of conduct agreement regarding expectations for appropriate behaviors for ALL players and parents!!

# **REGISTRATION COST:**

• U9-U10 = \$350/session

### **UNIFORMS:**

- Required Macron uniform for WDP players:
  - Home jersey (red)
  - Away jersey (white)
  - 1 pair of black shorts
  - 1 pair of red socks
  - Gray training top
- Additional items (i.e. extra training shirt/socks/shorts) may be purchased at parent's discretion!
- Uniform Cost: Under \$150
- WWAFC does not currently 'mark-up' required uniforms so it is 'at cost'
- We will hold Winter fitting sessions well in advance of the Spring season and parents are responsible for having their player attend one of these and then promptly purchasing all required kit from our MacronStore which is accessible from our website.

# TOURNAMENTS:

- Participation is at Coach and team discretion
- Goal is to attend one per session or two annually
- Spring is a very challenging season for tournaments due to lack of solid options, inclement weather and Memorial Day. WWAFC aims to host a Spring tournament in the near future!
- Late Summer/Fall provides better options
- We currently focus on 'In-State' travel options for tournaments but this could change in the future
